Thank you for your interest in visiting the Parliament of Bhutan. Please read the following information carefully before your visit.

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

- Parliamentary proceedings are open to the public. Sessions are announced in advance via official websites and media.
- Guided tours of the Parliament are available. Explore the architecture and legislative chambers of both houses.

2. SECURITY SCREENING

- All visitors must go through security screening and vehicle checks before entering the Parliament complex.
- Please arrive at least 20 minutes early to avoid delays.

3. IDENTIFICATION

- A valid ID card or passport is required for verification and issuance of an admission pass.
- The admission pass must be returned upon exit.

4. DRESS CODE

- Formal attire is mandatory. Entry will be denied to visitors who are not appropriately dressed.

5. PHOTOGRAPHY

- Photography is strictly prohibited within Parliament premises.

6. ENTRANCE AND PARKING

- Public parking is available, subject to availability.
